From March 1<sup>st</sup> through May 31<sup>st</sup>, Wood County had a total of 16 calls.

Josh Sabo gave the first responder's coordinator's report. There was a total of three calls this month. One resident has been removed from the Brown McChesney Home and still waiting for phone calls

We received an offer for the six-wheeler only for \$2,500.00. We will continue to advertise.

The board will look in to adopting an ordinance that would allow the fire department to have an account with their money in their own account.
