Resolution 1991-01

SUPPORTING ENTERING INTO A s.66.30 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR RECYCLING SERVICES WITH THE NORTHWEST RECYCLING BOARD.

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Act 335, the Recycling Law requires each municipality in the State of Wisconsin to provide for the recycling of solid waste produced by its residents; and,

WHEREAS, the economics of operating a recycling program are such that a jointly operated program would be beneficial to all municipalities involved; and,

WHEREAS, municipalities of northwestern Wood County and southwestern Marathon County have agreed to work cooperatively to develop and maintain a recycling program for the residents of their respective municipalities; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Richfield has received funds from the Department of Natural Resources for the development and start-up of a recycling program for residential solid waste produced within the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of the Town of Richfield authorizes the Chairman and Clerk to enter the Town of Richfield into an agreement as allowed by Section 66.30 of the Wisconsin Statutes for recycling services with the Northwest Recycling Board; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Richfield does hereby through contract under s. 66.30 designate the Northwest Recycling Board to be the responsible unit for recycling services provided to residents of the Town of Richfield; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Richfield shall name one (1) delegate to the Board within thirty (30) days of executing the Municipal Cooperative Agreement for recycling services, as the Board shall consist of one (1) delegate appointed from each member Municipality; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Richfield will fund the Northwest Recycling Board on an annual basis, with amount of funding determined by the annual budget process of the Board. The Board shall charge each municipality for recycling services based on a per-capita assessment, with population being determined by the U.S. Census Bureau's most current Decennial Census. The per-capita assessment will be equal for all member municipalities in the Board.
