Roads; Brian Albright will be fixing pot holes. He will be using a cold mix throughout the township and putting a hot tar mix over top the cold mix on everything east of hwy A to compare the value of the hot tar mix.

There are two culverts on Richfield Dr. that need to be replaced. One is by Josh Klumb's and the other is by Al Pickhard's.

We have been experiencing issues with the electrical system on the plow truck. We will be taking the plow truck to get an estimate on how much it would cost to have the plow truck refurbished.

Chris McDaniel had some concerns/questions on how the Town receives State Highway Aids. In the past State Highway Aid was based off how much an individual municipality spent

on their road related projects. Today, the Town's annual State Highway Aid is based off a rating system.
